

**VISIT TO THE INTERACTIVE MUSEUM OF THE HISTORY OF LUGO MIHL.
Architects: NIETO and SOBEJANO**

Last Friday, Feb 22, students and teachers were visiting the MIHL, designed by the architects Fuensanta Nieto and Enrique Sobejano and inaugurated in 2012 with an exhibition of Contemporary Art with emblematic pieces by more than 30 internationally important Galician artists.

The architects Nieto-Sobejano conceived the MIHL as a park-museum, where the initial idea is that the museum is part of the landscape. Much of the building is buried under a large garden very close to the Parque de la Milagrosa. The exterior of the building emerges from the ground in the form of large cylinders, covered with a lattice of Corten steel, which light up at night projecting towards the city the innovative image of the new museum.





We have chosen this building as the main theme for this course.

The central theme will be a work of architecture based on a graphic analysis which the students will carry out during the winter term. The practice will conclude with the students' proposing corporate images and designs for a signage program.
